SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By Decisions Nos. 58716 and 63116, dated July 7, 1959 and January 16, 1962, in Applications Nos. 40628, 40954 and 43578, Suburban Water Systems was restricted from extending service outside of its certificated service area without further order of the Commission.

By Advice Letter No. 63 received February 4, 1963, Suburban Water Systems requests authority to file a revised tariff service area map (Cal. P.U.C. Sheet No. 272-W) applicable in its Whittier Tariff Area to extend service to Tract No. 24968, and vicinity, Los Angeles County.

The utility indicates in its advice letter that, since 1956, it has served most of the approximately 100 acres of territory

to be added by this filing. The remaining portion, Tract No. 24968, is bounded on three sides by territory that is already being served and on the fourth side by a railroad right-of-way. This would make service to this tract by another water purveyor difficult and impractical.

Under the circumstances, we find that the utility should be permitted to serve Tract No. 24968, that the filing should be made effective, and that the proposed extension of service as indicated by the filing of the revised tariff service area map is not adverse to the public interest and is justified.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Suburban Water Systems is authorized to extend service to Tract No. 24968, Los Angeles County.

2. The revised tariff service area map filed by Suburban Water Systems with Advice Letter No. 63 will become effective on March 6, 1963.

3. Except for the authorization herein granted, the restrictions against extension of service imposed by the orders in Decisions Nos. 58716 and 63116 shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
