ORDER DENYING REHEARING
AND MODIFYING DECISION

Southern Pacific Company having filed a petition for rehearing of Decision No. 64641, requesting that rehearing be granted, or, in the alternative, that the Commission modify and amend said decision, and the Commission having considered said petition and each and every allegation therein, and being of the opinion that although no good cause for granting a rehearing has been made to appear, said Decision No. 64641 should be amended as ordered herein,

IT IS ORDERED that said petition for rehearing is hereby denied.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Decision No. 64641 is hereby amended as follows:

1. The second paragraph of the Opinion, beginning with the words "We find" on line 10 of sheet 1 and ending with the word "order" on line 7 of sheet 2 of the decision, is amended to read, as follows:

"We find and conclude from the record that public necessity, health and safety require the installation and/or synchronization of the protective safety and traffic signal devices as set forth in the following order."

2. The last two sentences of paragraph No. 3 of the Order, beginning with the word "Maintenance" on line 6 of sheet 3 and ending with the word "costs" on line 10 of sheet 3 of the decision, are deleted, and the following sentence is substituted therefor:

"Maintenance costs of signals, circuits and gates shall be borne in accordance with agreements entered into between the parties involved, or in the event the parties fail to agree, by further order of this Commission."
