OPINION AND ORDER

Souza's Milk Transportation Co. requests authority to discontinue service as a highway common carrier.

By Decision No. 53584 dated August 7, 1956, applicant was authorized to transport limited commodities between various points within the state.

As justification it is alleged that most of the commodities in the certificate are related to the dairy and creamery industry; that within the past four years most of applicant's customers have moved to location points beyond applicant's certificated authority; and that there is no present demand for applicant's service.

After consideration the Commission finds that the granting of the authority requested would not be adverse to the public interest. A public hearing is not necessary.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The certificate of public convenience and necessity authorizing Souza's Milk Transportation Co., a corporation, to operate as a highway common carrier granted and acquired by the following decisions is hereby revoked:

2. Local Freight Tariff No. 1, Cal. P.U.C. No. 1 (Series of Manuel Souza dte Souza's Milk Transportation), issued by Souza's Milk Transportation Co., a corporation, is hereby canceled.

3. Souza's Milk Transportation Co. is hereby directed to cause to be canceled its participation in bureau tariffs on file with this Commission, such cancellation to be made within ninety days after the effective date of this order on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and the public.

The Secretary of the Commission is directed to mail a copy of this order to Richard A. Bennett, Agent, C. R. Nickerson, Agent, and Western Classification Committee, Agent.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
