FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS the Commission, by Decision No. 64206, dated September 4, 1962, among other things, authorized Honor Oak Water Company to issue not to exceed 100 shares of its capital stock, at \$100 per share, on or before December 31, 1962, for the purpose of acquiring a certain water system, and

WHEREAS the company reports it did not issue its said stock prior to the expiration date specified in the Commission's decision but that it desires to do so,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Honor Oak Water Company may issue the 100 shares of capital stock authorized by Decision No. 64206, dated September 4, 1962, on or before April 30, 1963, for the purpose set forth in said decision, it being the opinion of the Commission that the money, property or labor to be procured

or paid for by the issue of said stock is reasonably required for said purpose, and that such purpose is not, in whole or in part, reasonably chargeable to operating expenses or to income.

2. This First Supplemental Order shall become effective on the date hereof.
