## SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 65093, entered today, the Commission increased the C.O.D. charges in Minimum Rate Tariff No. 2, in City Carriers' Tariff No. 1-A, and in eight other minimum rate tariffs. That decision also found that, in order to avoid duplication of tariff distribution, each tariff should be amended by separate order.

## IT IS ORDERED that:

1. City Carriers' Tariff No. 1-A (Appendix "A" of Decision No. 41363, as amended) is further amended by incorporating therein, to become effective May 11, 1963, Ninth Revised Page 18, which page is attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.

2. In all other respects the aforesaid Decision No. 41363, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION NO. 1 - RULES AND REGULATIONS OF GENERAL APPLICATION (Continued)
COLLECT ON DELIVERY (C.O.D.) SHIPMENTS
(a) No carrier shall handle any C.O.D. shipment unless and until it has on file with the Commission a good and sufficient bond in such form as the Commission may deem proper, in a sum of not less than Two Thousand Dollars.  (b) The bond required by paragraph (a) hereof, shall be filed by the carrier as principal and by some solvent surety company, authorized to do business in the State of California, as surety, payable to the State of California, and/or any person or persons to whom any amount may be due on any C.O.D. shipment transported by said carrier and not remitted to the person or persons to whom it is due within ten days after delivery of any such shipment; however, when the carrier has filed with any municipality or board thereof, pursuant to ordinance, a bond in a sum not less than Two Thousand Dollars, payable to said board or municipality and/or any person or persons to whom any amount may be due on any C.O.D. shipment transported by said carrier and not remitted to the person or persons to whom it is due within ten days after delivery of any such shipment, the filing by such carrier of a certified compliance herewith. Each bond filed pursuant to the foregoing shall specify the extent to which the carrier's operations are covered thereby and may cover more than one operative authority, said bond or bonds shall be revised or reissued to show whether or not the additional operative authority, said bond or bonds shall be revised or reissued to show whether or not the additional operative authority, said bond or bonds shall be revised or receded on less than thirty days' notice to the Commission.  (c) In the handling of C.O.D. shipments carrier shall, promptly upon collection of any and all C.O.D. moneys, and in no event later than ten days after delivery to consignee, unless consignor instructs otherwise in writing, remit to consignor all C.O.D. moneys collected by it on such shipments.
