O R D E R

The City of Santa Ana is hereby authorized to construct Talbert Avenue (new) at grade across a drill track of the Pacific Electric Railway Company in the City of Santa Ana, Orange County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 6N-39.07-C.

Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Pacific Electric Railway Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of the crossing shall be 84 feet and grades of approach not greater than three percent in accordance with plans attached to the application. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by four Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75-B). Backlights may be omitted on the signals located on the center median.

It appears that the existing crossing of old Talbert Avenue (Crossing No. 6N-39.00-C) would no longer be required if Susan Street is extended south to an intersection with the new Talbert Avenue and the City of Santa Ana should consider its elimination at that time.

Within thirty days after completion, pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
