ORDER OF DISMISSAL

It appearing that defendant had heretofore refused to establish telephone service at complainant's premises, 3821 Buckingham Road, Los Angeles, and

It appearing that such refusal was based upon a letter from the Los Angeles Police Department advising defendant that establishment of such service would result in its illegal use; and

It appearing that the Commission, on February 13, 1963, issued an order directing defendant to furnish telephone service to complainant pending further order herein; and

It appearing that the Los Angeles Police Department subsequent to reinvestigating the matter retracted, by letter, its earlier written communication, and

It appearing that defendant, pursuant to such retraction, and not because of the order of February 13, 1963, installed telephone service on February 15, 1963, at complainant's premises under telephone number AX 4-3786; and

It further appearing that complainant has made written request for dismissal of the complaint

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The Order granting interim relief, dated February 13, 1963, is vacated.
2. The Complaint herein is dismissed.
