O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct an industrial drill track at grade across Merced Street in the City of San Leandro, Alameda County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. L-16.19-C. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, without super-elevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding two percent. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75-B). Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

Applicant alleges that the industry to be served has requested immediate construction to avoid expense due to lack of adequate shipping facilities.

Consequently, the effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
