THIRD SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Respondent was required by ordering paragraphs 6 and 7 of Decision No. 63305 herein to take such action, including legal action as might be found necessary to collect undercharges set forth in said decision. A Second Supplemental Order herein relieved respondent from the duty of collecting from two of these that could not be found. All other collections have been made except in the cases of two companies. One of these has been liquidated. The other is in the hands of the Collector of Internal Revenue.

The Commission finds that it would not be in the public interest to require further collection effort from respondent.

IT IS ORDERED that Superior California Trucking Company, a corporation, is hereby relieved of the duties imposed upon it

by ordering paragraphs 6 and 7, as amended, of Decision No. 63305 in this proceeding.
