ORDER REVOKING OPERATIVE AUTHORITY

It appearing that, by Decision No. 27172 dated June 25, 1934 in Application No. 19483, George E. Trask was authorized to acquire a prescriptive passenger stage operative right authorizing service between Sonora and Columbia and intermediate points; that this right was restated by Decision No. 57518 in the same proceeding; that Mr. Trask's passenger traffic has been almost negligible, the passenger revenue for the month of January 1963, for example, being only \$3.75; that on March 1, 1963 Mr. Trask discontinued the passenger stage service theretofore conducted by him between Sonora and Columbia pursuant to the foregoing described operative right; and that George E. Trask has expressed his desire to discontinue service due to poor health; therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that the passenger stage operative rights, set forth in Decision No. 57518 in Application No. 19483, are hereby revoked and all effective tariffs and timetables on file with the Commission in the name of George E. Trask are hereby canceled.

The Secretary is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon George E. Trask or to mail a certified copy thereof to George E. Trask at Box 171, Columbia, Tuolumne County, California, last known address as shown in the Commission's records.

The effective date of this order shall be the 30th day after such service upon George E. Trask or after the above mailing to George E. Trask, as the case may be, unless before such effective date there shall have been filed with this Commission written response to this order requesting public hearing in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of the Commission.
