ORDER REVOKING OPERATIVE AUTHORITY

It appearing that, by Decision No. 61764 dated April 4, 1961, in Application No. 42851 as amended, Lee M. Mull was authorized to acquire a passenger stage operative right authorizing service between Crescent City Airport and Crescent City and between said points on the one hand, and on the other hand, Arcata, the Eureka-Arcata Airport, Eureka and the several airports in the Eureka area; that, during the month of June 1962, Lee M. Mull without appropriate authority, discontinued the passenger stage service theretofore conducted by him between the above-mentioned points pursuant to the foregoing described operative right; that, since June 24, 1962, Lee M. Mull has had no evidence on file with this Commission showing adequate protection against liability imposed by law for payment of damage for personal injury or property damage, as required by General Order No. 101-A and that Lee M. Mull has allegedly left the State of California; therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that the passenger stage operative rights, created by Decision No. 61764 in Application No. 42851 as amended, are hereby revoked and all effective tariffs and timetables on file with the Commission in the name of Lee M. Mull are hereby canceled.

The Secretary is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon Lee M. Mull or to mail a certified copy thereof to Lee M. Mull at 1145 Northcrest Drive, Crescent City, California, last known address as shown in the Commission's records.

The effective date of this order shall be the thirtieth day after such service upon Lee M. Mull or after the above mailing to Lee M. Mull, as the case may be, unless before such effective date there shall have been filed with this Commission written response to this order requesting public hearing in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of the Commission.
