O R D E R

The City of Santa Maria is hereby authorized to construct Morrison Avenue at grade across Roadamite Branch of the Santa Maria Valley Railroad Company (formerly the United States of America Railroad), at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 38B-5.69-C, in the City of Santa Maria, County of Santa Barbara.

Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. The Santa Maria Valley Railroad Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines.

Width of crossing shall be 40 feet in accordance with plans attached to the application, and grades of approach not greater than two percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75-B).

Within thirty days after completion, pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless

time be extended or if the above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
