INTERIM OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 64645 this Commission authorized the Glendale City Lines, Inc, to discontinue passenger stage service in Glendale and contiguous territory. The order provided in part that the company "shall not dispose of any of its assets pending further order of this Commission, to be issued after hearing on the question of severance damages has been held."

By petition filed April 8, 1963, the Glendale City Lines, Inc. alleges that on June 4, 1962, it sold to and obtained a deposit of two hundred (\$200.00) dollars from the American International Bus Exchange, Division of Carson Enterprises, Inc., 8659 Quinn Street, Downey, California, for thirteen (13) G.M.C. buses, Model T.G. 3609. The total sale price was two thousand (\$2,000.00) dollars. The balance of the purchase price would be paid to the Glendale City Lines, Inc. when the buses were removed from the premises and the buses were permitted to remain on the premises of the Glendale City Lines, Inc. until such time as a buyer for the buses was located.

The petition further alleges that the American International Bus Exchange has now located a buyer and wishes to remove the buses from the premises of the Glendale City Lines, Inc. It is alleged that unless delivery can be made to the buyer by April 11, 1963, the sale will be forfeited.

After consideration, the Commission finds that the proposed sale would not be adverse to the public interest. A public hearing is not necessary.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the Glendale City Lines, Inc. may sell to the American International Bus Exchange thirteen (13) gasoline powered buses listed below:

2. The amount received for this sale shall be deposited in a separate bank account to be held in trust pending further order of this Commission.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
