OPINION AND ORDER

A Commission staff member having determined, after examination and appraisal as required in Section 5135 of the Public Utilities Code, that applicant is not qualified for a household goods carrier permit, the matter was set for hearing at Los Angeles on March 8, 1963, before Examiner Chiesa.

The evidence shows and we find that on November 14, 1962, applicant James Hale failed to pass the prescribed written examination; that on December 5, 1962, said applicant failed to pass a second written examination; that James Hale and Brown Hale appeared at the hearing and were given an opportunity to present evidence of their qualifications for a household goods carrier permit; that they failed to present such evidence, and that applicant does not possess the required knowledge and ability to engage in business as a household goods carrier.

IT IS ORDERED that Application No. 45014 is denied.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
