O R D E R

City of Davis is hereby authorized to construct East Eighth Street at grade across tracks of the Southern Pacific Company in the City of Davis, Yolo County, at the location described in the application to be identified as Crossing No. AE-76.3. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than 44 feet and grades of approach not greater than 3 percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75-B) with crossing bells damped.

Upon completion, Crossing No. AE-76.2, Cemetery Road, about 200 feet southerly shall be abandoned and closed. Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified

if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The contractor is ready to proceed with the street relocation at once. The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
