O P I N I O N

Applicant, sole legal heir of the estate of her father, Julio Martinez, requests an order transferring ownership to her of the "J. Martinez Water System", in Santa Ana, California, to which she has succeeded by virtue of a decree of distribution rendered February 16, 1962 by the Superior Court of the State of California in and for the County of Orange (Case No. A-37167). A copy of the Order Settling Final Account of Administratrix and Decree of Distribution is annexed as an exhibit to the application.

We find that the requested transfer of ownership of the "J. Martinez Water System" to applicant will not be adverse to the public interest and should be authorized in accordance with the following order. The action taken herein, however, shall not be construed to be a finding of value of the properties herein authorized to be transferred. A public hearing is not necessary.

O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Celia Rebecca Holguin, applicant herein, after the effective date of this order and on or before December 31, 1963, may acquire and, following such acquisition, operate the public

utility water company properties known as the "J. Martinez Water System", in the City of Santa Ana, California.

2. Applicant, within thirty days after acquisition of said properties pursuant to this order, shall, as the new owner, file an appropriate Notice of Adoption of the effective tariff schedules of "J. Martinez Water System", said notice to be submitted in the form of an advice letter pursuant to the provisions of Section III of General Order No. 96-A.

3. Applicant, within ninety days after the date of acquisition, shall file revised rules governing service to customers, a tariff service area map, and copies of printed forms normally used in connection with customers' services. Such filing shall be in conformity with General Order No. 96-A, and the new and revised sheets, if acceptable to this Commission, shall become effective upon the fifth day after having been filed.

4. The Estate of Julio Martinez, on or before the date of actual transfer, shall refund all customers' deposits for the establishment of credit and advances for construction, if any, which are subject to refund as of that date. Any unrefunded deposits and advances shall be transferred to applicant, who will then become obligated to make refunds when due.

5. The Estate of Julio Martinez, upon compliance with the foregoing provision of this order, shall stand relieved of all further public utility obligations in connection with

the public utility water system herein authorized to be transferred.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
