OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 59710, dated February 23, 1960, in Applications Nos. 41589 and 41613, Catalina Island Sightseeing Lines and M.G.R.S., Inc., were authorized to execute the following agreements:

1. Charter of S.S.Catalina and terms covering certain other properties and facilities;
2. Agreement covering the term of the Bareboat Charter Party;
3. Agreement for use of the Wilmington Terminal;
4. Agreement of lease for Avalon Pier Terminal.

By Decision No. 63629, in Application No. 44322, applicants were authorized to extend the terms of said agreements for a one-year period commencing January 1, 1962 and ending December 31, 1962.

With the exception of the Wilmington Terminal lease, which terminated December 31, 1962, applicants request that they be authorized to extend the terms of the other three agreements to December 31, 1963. Copies of the extension agreements are attached to the application as Exhibits 1 through 3.

After consideration, the Commission finds and concludes that the authority requested should be granted. This finding does not include any approval of the rentals set forth in the agreements, for rate-making purposes. A public hearing is not necessary.

Therefore, good cause appearing, IT IS ORDERED that Catalina Island Sightseeing Lines and M.G.R.S., Inc., are hereby authorized to enter into and make effective the extension agreements attached to the application and designated as Exhibits Nos. 1 to 3, inclusive. This authorization constitutes no approval as to the reasonableness of the rentals for rate-making purposes.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
