## ORDER REVOKING WAREHOUSE OPERATIVE RIGHT

By order of the Commission, dated August 16, 1960, in this proceeding, the Commission determined that Harold W. Stewart possessed a prescriptive operative right as a public utility warehouseman for the operation of storage or warehouse floor space in Barstow.

By letters received by the Commission on January 22 and February 27, 1963, Harold W. Stewart has informed the Commission that he "turned the business back to Earl M. Newbern in October of 1961," did not conduct any public utility warehouse business in 1961, had no income to report from public warehouse operations for 1961, and discontinued service as a public utility warehouseman in October 1961.

In the circumstances, it appears, and the Commission finds, that Harold W. Stewart has abandoned public utility warehouse operations and that such abandonment constitutes good cause for revocation of the public utility warehouse operative right herein involved and cancellation of tariff applicable thereto; and that such revocation will not be adverse to the public interest. A public hearing is not necessary.

## IT IS ORDERED that:

- 1. The public utility warehouse operative right determined by the order of the Commission dated August 16, 1960, in Case No. 6844, is hereby revoked.
- 2. Warehouse Tariff No. 1, Cal.P.U.C. No. 1, issued by Harold W. Stewart, doing business as Barstow Transfer & Storage Co., is hereby canceled.

The Secretary of the Commission is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon Harold W. Stewart or to mail a certified copy thereof to him at his last known address as shown in the Commission's records.

The effective date of this order shall be the thirtieth day after such service or after the above mailing, as the case may be, unless before such effective date there shall have been filed with this Commission a written request for public hearing, in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of the Commission.
