OPINION AND ORDER

G. S. Bobb, Aaron F. Bobb and C. R. Christensen, doing business as Union Storage Co., are authorized to operate as a public utility warehouseman at Woodland and vicinity and at Merritt (Merritt Station) both located in Yolo County.¹

By this application, as amended, authority is sought to discontinue the public utility warehouse operation at Merritt Station. Applicants state that the lease on the Merritt Station warehouse expired May 31, 1962, and that they have discontinued the warehouse operation at that location. They also state that other storage space for the commodities customarily stored in their warehouse is available in the same area.

Upon consideration of the allegation contained in the amended application, it appears, and the Commission finds, that the discontinuance of the public utility warehouse operation at Merritt Station will not be adverse to the public interest. A public hearing is not necessary. The application will be granted.

Good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. G. S. Bobb, Aaron F. Bobb and C. R. Christensen, doing business as Union Storage Co., may discontinue public utility warehouse operations at Merritt (Merritt Station) upon the effective date

of tariff amendments which they may cause to be filed with the Commission removing that location from the tariffs, said amendments to be made effective not earlier than the tenth day after the effective date of this order on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public.

2. Effective concurrently with the effective date of tariff filings authorized by Ordering Paragraph 1 hereof the operative authority of applicants as a public utility warehouseman at Merritt (Merritt Station) is hereby revoked.

3. The authority herein granted shall expire unless exercised within one hundred twenty days after the effective date hereof.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
