ORDER DENYING REHEARING
AND AMENDING DECISION NO. 64802

California Trucking Associations, Inc., having filed a petition for rehearing of Decision No. 64802, and the Commission having considered said petition and each and every allegation therein, and being of the opinion that no good cause for rehearing has been made to appear;

IT IS ORDERED that said petition for rehearing is hereby denied.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the order in Decision 64802 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"IT IS ORDERED that:

"1. The mileages, maps, rules and other provisions as specified in the preceding opinion shall be adopted as Distance Table No. 5.

"2. Distance Table No. 5 shall not be applicable to any minimum rate tariff until so ordered in a minimum rate proceeding pertaining to that minimum rate tariff.

"3. Prior to the scheduling of any hearing relative to the applicability of the distance table to any minimum rate tariff, a subsequent order will be issued and served in this proceeding whereby the parties of record will be informed fully and in detail of the constructive mileages, zones, rules, indices, and other contents of Distance Table No. 5 as herein determined by the Commission.

"4. By subsequent order in this proceeding, the effective date of Distance Table No. 5 will be established. Distance Table No. 5 will be prepared, printed and served, prior to its being made applicable to any minimum rate tariff.

"This order shall become effective twenty days after the date hereof."
