Southern Pacific Company is hereby authorized to construct one additional spur track at grade across Lonoak Road in Monterey County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. E-164.3

Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the road now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding 3 percent. Protection shall be by two existing Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75-B). Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

Applicant desires to begin construction as soon as possible because the industry located on this proposed track is in need

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of immediate service to avoid expensive delay in shipping seasonable produce and has requested immediate authorization.
