BEFORE THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

Supplemental application of the County of Sonoma, acting through its Board of Supervisors, for permission to construct a crossing at grade, on the access road to the Cloverdale Airport, across the main line of the Northwestern Pacific Railroad southerly of the City of Cloverdale.

O R D E R

The County of Sonoma is hereby authorized to construct the access road to the Cloverdale Airport at grade across a track of the Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company near Cloverdale, Sonoma County, at the location described in the application to be identified as Crossing No. 5-82.5. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than 24 feet and grades of approach not greater than six percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B) reflectorized with reflex-reflective sheet material.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with.

Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
