AND DENYING REHEARING



IT IS ORDERED that mimeographed page 19 of Decision No. 65115 is amended by adding thereto the following finding:

We further find that present water supplies are adequate to enable Temescal to furnish water for resale by Corona City Water Company in the area served by Corona City Water Company, and to enable Temescal to furnish irrigation water to consumers of such water in the service area specified in the order herein.

Rehearing of Decision No. 65115, as amended, is hereby denied.
