ORDER VACATING SUSPENSION
AND INVESTIGATION ORDER

On November 8, 1962, the Commission issued an order of investigation as above-entitled which, among other things, suspended to and including March 31, 1963, the changes in Schedules Nos. 1-T, 43-T, 89-T, 90-T, 120-T and 124-T filed under Advice Letter No. 8329 by The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company. Thereafter, the period of suspension was extended to and including September 30, 1963. By Decision No. 65019 dated March 6, 1963, the tariff sheets of Schedule No. 43-T filed under said Advice Letter No. 8329 were permanently suspended.

Prior to the hearing, respondent, having requested, by Advice Letter No. 8329, Supplement, permission to withdraw the remaining suspended tariff sheets and the Commission finding that granting of such request can be accomplished by permanent suspension, that it is not adverse to the public interest, and that hearing in this matter is not necessary; therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that the changes in Schedules Nos. 1-T, 89-T, 90-T, 120-T and 124-T filed under Advice Letter No. 8329 are hereby

permanently suspended and this proceeding is discontinued as of the date hereof.

The Secretary is directed to cause a certified copy of this order to be served upon The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company, 140 New Montgomery Street, San Francisco 5, California.
