BEFORE THE PUBLIC UITIITIES COMMISSION OF TEE STATE OF CALIFORRIA.

APPLication of THE GREYHOUND CORPORATION for authority to reroute passenger staze service between the junction of Yorts Boulevard and Figueroa Street in the City Application No. 4,5208 of Los Angeles and Pasadena, over alternate) U. S. Hizhway ©6, Los Anzeles County; and for incidental relief.

## QPINIQN:

The Greyhound Corporation requests authority to reroute service between the junction of York Boulevard and Figueroa Srreet in the City of Los Angeles and Pasacina over Alternãe U. S. Eigliway 6u.

It is alieged that the present route is over heavily traveled city streets with stop signs, signal lights, cross traffic, pedestrian trafific and curb paricing whici result in delays; and that adoption of the proposed route would eliminate delays of from î to 15 mimutes in schedules operated between Pasadena and Ios Angeles.

After considezation the Comission Einds that public convenience and necessity require the granting of the authority sought. A putilic heaxine is not necessary.

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IT IS ORDERED that:
I. A certificate of public convenience and necessiny is hereby granted to The Greyhound Corporation, authorizing the
establishmenc and operation of service as a passenger staze corporation, as that term is defined in Section 226 of the Public UEilities Code, for the transportation of passengers, baggage and express between the points and over the routes set forth in Fifth Revised Paze 60, attached hereto, as an extension and enlargement of, consolidation with and subject to all the limitations and restrictions set forth in the cercificate granted by Decision No. 55893 and in particular subject to the provisions set forth in Section 3 of Appendix A thereof.
2. Appendix A of Decision No. 55393 is hereby amended by incorporating Fifth Revised Page 50 in revision of Fourth Revisce Page 60.
3. In provicing service pursuant to the certificate herein eranted, applicanc shall comply with and observe the following, service regulations:
(a) Within thirty days after the effective date hereof, applicant shall file a written acceptance of the certificare kerein granted.
(b) Within one hundred Ewenty days after the effective date hercof, applicant shall eftablish the service herein authorized and file in the Comission's office in tripiicate taziffs and timetables satisfactory to the Comaission.
(c) The cariff and cimetable filings shall be made effective not carider than ten daysafrez the effective date of this order on not less than ren days' notice to the Comission and the public, and the effective date of the tarifs and vimetable filings shail be concurrent with the escablisiment of the service herein authorized.

(d) The caries and timetable Eilincs made pourstane to this order shall comply with the regulations governing the construction and filing of vatitfs and timetables set forth in the Commission's General Orders Nos. 75 and 98.

* 18.01 - Between Los Angeles and the Califormia-Arizona State Ine east of NeedIes:

From Los Angeles, over urban routes to junction of Figneroa Street and Avenue 26 , thence over alternate U. S. Highway 66 to Pasadena, thence over Foothill Boulevard to Monrovia, thence over Myrtie Avenue to junction U. S. Highway 66, thence over U. S. Highway 66 to junction access highway to Main Street (West Barstow Junction), thence over access highway and Main Street through Barstow to junction U. S. Highway 66 (East Barstow Junction), thence over U. S. Highway 66 to the point where it intersects the CaliformiaAxizona State Line.

No local schedules (other than interstate schedules) shall be operated between San Bernardino and the Califormia-Arizona State Iine east of Needles.

Between San Bemardino and the Galifornia-Axizona State Ifine east of Needles the transportation of express is restricted to passenger-carrying vehicles used in interstate service.
18.02 - Between Barstow and the Califomia-Nevada State Line near Wheaton Springs:

From Barstow, over U. S. Highway 91 to the point where it intersects the California-Nevada State Ine.
18.03 - Between Los Angeles and the CaIifornia-Arizona State Iine east of Blythe:

From Los Angeles, over urban routes to U. S. Highway 60-70-99, thence over U. S. Highway 60-70-99 to West Pomona, thence ove: U. S. Highway 60 to Beamont, thence over U. S. Highway 60-70-99 to Indio, thence over U. S. Highway 60-70 to the point where it intersects the California-Arizona State Line east of Blythe.
