O R D E R

The City of Tustin is hereby authorized to construct Gwyneth Drive at grade across the track of The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 2-181.5-C, in the City of Tustin, County of Orange.

Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines.

Width of crossing shall be 36 feet and grades of approach not greater than two percent in accordance with plan attached to the application. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B), with reflex reflecting sheet material.

Within thirty days after completion, pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless

time be extended or if the above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
