OPINION AND ORDER

Applicant holds radial highway common carrier, highway contract carrier and city carrier permits. 1 By Decision No. 63726 dated May 22, 1962, in Application No. 44384, applicant was authorized to transport brandy, in barrels, for Fromm & Sichel, Inc., between Lac Jac, on the one hand, and Biola, Fowler, Monmouth, Mission Bell and Lodi, on the other hand, at rates less than the established minimum rates. The current authority is scheduled to expire with June 17, 1963.

By this application, applicant seeks authority to continue in effect the currently authorized rates, except the rate from and to Lodi, for a further one-year period.²

Applicant alleges that the general conditions concerning the transportation characteristics involved have remained virtually unchanged since the current authority was granted; that the volume of traffic under the current authority has been greater than

minimum rates but not less than the following, subject to a minimum weight of 40,000 pounds per shipment:

Biola	16.5
Fowler	13
Monmouth	13
Mission Bell	19

2. The authority herein granted shall, on and after June 17, 1963, supersede the authority granted by Decision No. 63726, and shall expire with June 17, 1964.

This order shall become effective twenty days after the date hereof.
