Railway Express Agency, Incorporated has applied to the Commission for authorization to sell to Hearst Publishing Company, Inc. certain real property and improvements located at Folsom and Hawthorne Streets, San Francisco, now vacant but formerly used by applicant as its headquarters for its Pacific Region.

The Commission has considered the matter and finds that a public hearing is not necessary, that the proposed sale will not be adverse to the public interest, and that the application should be granted.

IT IS ORDERED that Railway Express Agency, Incorporated be, and it hereby is, authorized to sell to Hearst Publishing Company, Inc. the real property and improvements referred to in this application.

The authorization herein granted is not to be construed as a finding of the value of said real property and improvements.
