Application of the County of Sacramento to construct a grade crossing of the Application No. 45279 Sacramento Northern Railroad at "I" Street.)

ORDER

County of Sacramento is hereby authorized to widen the crossing of "I" Street at grade with a track of Sacramento Northern Railway, (Crossing No. 8-102.4) near Rio Linda, Sacramento County, as described in the application and in accordance with the plan attached thereto. Width of crossing shall be not less than twenty-four feet and grades of approach not greater than three percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B) reflectorized with reflex-reflective sheet material.

Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails.

Sacramento Northern Railway shall bear maintenance cost between such lines.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require.

Applicant desires to begin construction as soon as possible and has requested immediate authorization. The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
