The complaint will be zet for hearing before such comiseloner or Examiner, and at such time and place, as may hereafter be designated. The Secretary is directed as follows:

1. To cause a certified copy of this order, together with a copy of the complaint herein, to be served upon Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company, a corporation, and said defendant is directed to serve and file its reply within ten (10) days after said service.
2. To cause a copy of this order to be mailed to complainant.
3. To cause appropriate notice of hearing to be mailed to the paries at least ten (10) days prior to the hearing herein.
