In the Matter of the Application of the County of Shasta, a Political Subdivision of the State of California, for the Permanent Retention of Public County Highway Crossing at Grade over the Southern Pacific Railroad Company Tracks at S. P. Milepost C-250.5, superseding temporary authorization, and for the abandonment of Public County Highway Crossing at grade across the Southern Pacific Railroad Company tracks at S. P. Milepost C-250.2.

O R D E R

County of Shasta is hereby authorized to construct a county road at grade across tracks of Southern Pacific Company near Girvan, Shasta County, at the location described in the application to be identified as Crossing No. C-250.5. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than thirty feet and grades of approach not greater than two percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection, to be installed not later than December 31, 1963, shall be by two Standard No. 8 crossing signals (General Order No. 75-B) equipped with reflectorized "STOP ON RED SIGNAL" signs. Interim protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs reflectorized with reflex-reflective sheet material.

Upon completion of the crossing signal protection at Crossing No. C-250.5, Crossing No. C-250.2, located about 1,800 feet southerly, shall be abolished by physical closing by Southern Pacific Company. Within thirty days after completion

pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
