FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

By Decision No. 65504, dated June 4, 1963, the Commission, among other things, authorized Southern California Water Company, pursuant to its application, to issue not to exceed 1,800 shares of its common stock in exchange for outstanding shares of stock of Delmann Water Company.

Southern California Water Company filed an amendment to its application on June 3, 1963, so as to increase to 2,000 shares the amount of the requested stock authorization for said exchange, it appearing that subsequent data indicate the additional shares will be required. The amendment was not reflected in said Decision No. 65504.

The Commission has considered this matter and is of the opinion that the request of the company should be granted; and that the money, property or labor to be procured or paid for by the issue by Southern California Water Company of the shares of stock herein authorized is reasonably required for the purpose specified herein, which purpose is not, in whole or in part, reasonably chargeable to operating expenses or to income; therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Ordering Paragraph No. 1 of Decision No. 65504, dated June 4, 1963, is hereby amended so as to authorize the issue by Southern California Water Company of not to exceed 2,000 shares of common stock, instead of 1,800 shares, for the purpose set forth therein.

2. This First Supplemental Order shall become effective on the date hereof.
