## ORDER

City of Roseville is hereby authorized to construct a road crossing at grade across tracks of Southern Pacific Company in the City of Roseville, Placer County, at the location described in the application to be identified as Crossing No. A-107.5. Construction expense shall be borne in accord with an agreement to be entered into between the parties involved, or if they fail to agree, by further order of the Commission. Applicant shall bear maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than forty-nine feet and grades of approach not greater than four percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 3 crossing signals (General Order No. 75-B) supplemented with automatic gate arms.

Upon completion and opening of Crossing No. A-107.5 to vehicular traffic, Crossing No. A-107.2, Berry Street, located about 1,750 feet westerly shall be abolished by physical closing by Southern Pacific Company.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This

Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
