SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION

By petition filed April 8, 1963, The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company seeks an order amending the second ordering paragraph of Decision No. 65116 wherein defendant is required to submit to the Commission certain reports respecting defendant's prewiring and postwiring activities.

In the petition defendant avers that compilation of the requested cost data for its entire operations in California and with respect to all types of construction would cost well in excess of \$2,000,000. Defendant requests, therefore, that the order respecting cost data be modified in two ways; first, that reports as to cost data be confined to one Plant administrative district in each operating area for a 90-day period and, second, that reports as to

cost data be confined to dwellings instead of all construction. Petitions in opposition to the requested modification of Decision No. 65116 were filed by interveners and a concurrence therewith was filed by complainant.

After giving due consideration to the positions of all parties to this proceeding and to the objective of securing cost data which will be indicative of the magnitude and relative costs of defendant's rewiring and post-wiring activities, we find it will be reasonable to grant defendant's request for amendment to ordering paragraph 2 of Decision No. 65116, provided that the reports to be submitted will cover only the first installations made in newly constructed dwellings and further provided that the selection of a 90-day period and of Plant administrative districts for cost reporting will be subject to review and approval of the Commission.

SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that ordering paragraph 2 of Decision No. 65116 is amended to read as follows:

2. The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company shall submit to the Commission

(a) four quarterly reports commencing with the fourth quarter of 1963 which will contain the following information for first

installations made in newly constructed dwellings, segregated between single family dwellings and multiple-unit dwellings (except high-rise apartments), for its entire operations in California:

(1) number of units prewired, and (2) number of units postwired; and

(b) a report covering a 90-day period during the year which will contain the following information for first installations made in newly constructed dwellings, segregated between single family dwellings and multiple unit dwellings (except high-rise apartments), for one representative Plant administrative district in each operating area: (1) number of units prewired, (2) cost of prewiring, (3) average cost of prewiring per unit, (4) number of units postwired, (5) cost of postwiring, (6) average cost of postwiring per unit, and (7) such other detail or explanation as will facilitate the evaluation of the data.

(c) the selection of a 90-day period and of Plant administrative districts for cost

reporting, required under subparagraph 2.(b) above, will be submitted to the Commission for review and approval within thirty days after the effective date of this order.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
