<u>OPINION</u>

The Greyhound Corporation requests authority to sell its terminal property to The Redevelopment Agency of the City of Santa Cruz.

The buyer has instituted condemnation proceedings in the Superior Court in and for the County of Santa Cruz; however, applicant and The Redevelopment Agency have agreed that \$92,000 represents the fair market value of the property. According to the agreement between the parties the sale is to be consummated and title transferred on June 28, 1963, and subsequent thereto applicant will be allowed to remain in possession of said premises until December 31, 1963, pursuant to a month-to-month lease at a monthly rental of \$325. During the lease period applicant intends to acquire suitable and adequate terminal facilities in the City of Santa Cruz.

After consideration the Commission finds that the proposed sale would not be adverse to the public interest. A public hearing is not necessary.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that after the effective date hereof
The Greyhound Corporation may sell its terminal property in the
City of Santa Cruz to The Redevelopment Agency of the City of
Santa Cruz.
