 tion with the construction of Inter-
 state Route No. 5.

ORDER

The County of Shasta is hereby authorized to construct Deschutes Road at separated grades over the track of Southern Pacific Company, near Anderson, Shasta County, at the location and substantially in the manner shown by Exhibits A and B attached to the application, to be identified as Crossing No. C-246.1-A. Construction and maintenance expense shall be borne in accordance with an agreement to be entered into between the parties relative thereto, and copy of said agreement, together with plans of said crossing approved by Southern Pacific Company, shall be filed with the Commission within 180 days from the date hereof. Should the parties fail to agree, the Commission will apportion the cost of construction and maintenance by further order. Clearances shall conform to the provisions of General Order No. 26-D.

Upon completion of the overpass structure, Deschutes Road, Crossing No. C-246.1, at grade shall be abandoned and closed to public use and travel.

This project was assigned priority number four in this Commission's Decision No. 64630 dated December 11, 1962, which established the 1963 grade separation priority list pursuant to Sections 189-191 of the Streets and Highways Code.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within three years unless time be extended or if conditions are not complied with. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
