O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company is hereby authorized to construct a spur track at grade upon and across the easterly half of Alameda Street in the City of Los Angeles, County of Los Angeles, at the location described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. BG-484.06-C. Applicant shall bear the entire construction expense. Construction of crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding one percent, in accordance with plan attached to the application. Protection shall be by one Standard No. 1 crossing sign (General Order No. 75-3), with reflex reflecting sheet material.

Within thirty days after completion, pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied

with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
