ORDER SETTING ASIDE ORDER GRANTING  
INTERIM RELIEF AND ORDERING GENERAL  
TELEPHONE COMPANY OF CALIFORNIA TO  
RESTORE TELEPHONE SERVICE  
PENDING FURTHER ORDER

Mrs. Esther S. Ewing heretofore filed a complaint for restoration of telephone service against The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company in the above-numbered proceeding. The Commission by Decision No. 65602, dated June 18, 1963, granted interim relief and ordered defendant The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company to restore telephone service pending further Commission order herein.

It appears that the telephone service involved was not furnished to plaintiff by said defendant, but was furnished to her by General Telephone Company of California, a corporation; that the latter has waived the defect in complainant's pleading by filing its answer to said complaint; that said interim decision should be set aside and that the caption of said proceeding should be corrected by the substitution of General Telephone Company of

California as defendant in the place and stead of The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company.

Good cause appearing, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Decision No. 65602 is hereby set aside; that the caption of the complaint in the above-entitled proceeding is corrected by substituting General Telephone Company of California, a corporation, as defendant in the place and stead of The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company, a corporation; that General Telephone Company of California, a corporation, is hereby directed to reconnect and restore telephone service to complainant and to maintain such service pending further Commission order herein, said service to be furnished pursuant to defendant's filed tariff rates and rules applicable thereto. The complaint will be set for hearing before such Commissioner or Examiner, and at such time and place, as may hereafter be designated.

The Secretary is directed as follows:

1. To cause a copy of this order to be mailed to complainant.
2. To cause appropriate notice of hearing to be mailed to the parties at least ten (10) days prior to the hearing herein.
