In the Matter of the Application of SOUTHERN PACIFIC COMPANY for authority to construct at grade a railroad track in, upon and across North 10th Street, an unnamed street, Old Bayshore Highway, Queen's Lane, Rogers Avenue and Brokaw Road and underneath an overpass of State Route 69, all in the City of San Jose, County of Santa Clara, State of California.)

ORDER

Southern Pacific Company is hereby authorized to construct a railroad track at grade across certain streets in the City of San Jose, Santa Clara County, at the locations described in the application, to be identified as follows:

Construction of said crossings shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the streets now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding three percent. Protection shall be as follows:

Standard No. 8 flashing light signals and Standard No. 1 signs shall conform to General Order No. 75-B. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense. Clearances shall conform to the provisions of General Order No. 26-D.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
