O R D E R

County of Ventura is hereby authorized to construct Sequoia Avenue at grade across the main line of the Southern Pacific Company's Coast Line, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. E-436.1, in the County of Ventura.

Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. The Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines.

Width of the crossing shall be 64 feet and grades of approach not greater than five percent, in accordance with plans attached to the application. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75-B), supplemented with automatic crossing gates.

Within thirty days after completion, pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization

may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
