O R D E R

Town of Yreka City is hereby authorized to construct a road at grade across a track of Yreka Western Railroad Company near the Town of Yreka City, Siskiyou County, at the location described in the application to be identified as Crossing No. 47-6.6. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Yreka Western Railroad Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than 28 feet and grades of approach not greater than five percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B) reflectorized with reflex-reflective sheet material.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

Applicant desires to begin construction as soon as possible in order to make early use of a new garbage disposal site and has

requested immediate authorization. The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
