SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

The Commission by Decision No. 65427, issued May 21, 1963, in the above-entitled matter, authorized the transfer sought. Rehearing was denied by Decision No. 65661, on July 9, 1963, thus making the original decision effective. Said Decision No. 65427 provided, among other things, that the tariffs required to be filed be made effective not earlier than thirty days after the effective date of the order. Applicants had sought from the Interstate Commerce Commission similar authority to that requested of this Commission. It was granted also provided service was instituted by July 19, 1963. Such service was duly commenced but is uneconomical unless combined with the intrastate operation. Coast Drayage has filed a written request for authority to make its tariff effective on one day's notice. The tariff in question is a bureau tariff which has been on file with this Commission since November 1, 1955. Adoption thereof by Coast Drayage is all that is necessary. It appearing desirable and practical to grant the relief sought,

IT IS ORDERED that Ordering Paragraph 4 of Decision No. 65427 is amended to read as follows:

Coast Drayage shall amend or reissue the tariffs on file with the Commission, naming rates, rules and regulations governing the common carrier operations herein to show that it has adopted or established, as its own, said rates, rules and regulations. The tariff filings shall be made effective on one day's notice to the Commission and the public, and the effective date of the tariff filings shall be concurrent with the consummation of the transfer herein authorized. The tariff filings made pursuant to this order shall comply in all respects with the regulations governing the construction and filing of tariffs set forth in the Commission's General Order No. 80-A.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
