O R D E R

Pacific Electric Railway Company is hereby authorized to construct an additional spur track at grade across the south roadway of West Seventh Street in the City of Long Beach, Los Angeles County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as portion of Crossing No. 6LDB-1.72-C.

Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, and of a width of 30 feet without super-elevation and with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding two percent in accordance with plan attached to the application. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B), with reflex reflecting sheet material.

Within thirty days after completion, pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with.

Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require.

The industry is now in the process of constructing its building, portion of which is expected to be completed by August 15, and desires to commence construction of the trackage as soon as possible. For that reason, waiver of the twenty-day period is requested.

The effective date of this order shall therefore be the date hereof.
