## OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 63864 dated June 26, 1962, in Appication No. 4 48, Keency Iruck Innes, Inc., Grain Procucts Division, was authorized, as a permit carrier, to assess montily vehicle unit rates and charges which are less tinan the minimum rates and charges between specified points in Southern California for transportation for General Valis, Inc. The authority is scheauled to expire with Juiy 31, 1963.

By this appilcation, autiority is sougnt to continue to charge less than the established minimum rates and to increase the currently authozizec rates. ${ }^{\text {. }}$

Copy of the application was served upon California Trucking Association on or about May 16, 1963. No objection to its being granted has been received.

No autinority for the increase is required inasmuch as appincant performs the transportation as a permitted carrier for which only minimum rates have been established. Authority to continue the use of the sought rates beyond July 31, 1963, is requared, however, inasmuch as the rates differ from the minimum zates otherwise
applicable.

Since 1938 applicant anc its predecessors have becn authorized to perform the transportation services herein involvec at zates loss than tinose which otherwise would be applicable as minimum. The authorization has been extended from year to year, with revisions and increases in tine rates as necessary.

The present appiseation incluces a profit and loss statement for the year 1962, related to the transportation services herein involved. The statement shows that the higher rates as herein proposed were made effective on September 1, 1962, by voluntary agreement between applicant and the shipper, to coincide with the effective date of increased labor costs. Tne statement indicates that the operations for the year 1962 were profitable.

Applicant alleges that the operation continues to be profitable, and that the deviation is beneficial to both the shipper and applicant.

In the circumstances, it appears, and the Commission finds, that the proposed rates are reasonable and consistent with the publie interest. A pubilc hearing is not necessary. The application should be granted.

Because the conditions under which the service is performed may change at any time, the authority will be 1 imisted to expire with Juily 31 , 1964, unless sooner canceled, changed or extended by order of the Comission. In view of the impencing expiration date of the . current authority, the order wifch follows will be made effective July 31, 1.963.

hereby authorized to transport all commodities for General Kills, Inc., at rates and charges which differ from those established as minimum but not less than those specified between the points shown in and subject to the rules and regulations set forth in Appendix. $A$ attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.
2. The authority herein granted shall, on and after July 31, 1963, supersede the authority granted by Decision No. 63864 and shall expire with July 31, 1964, unless sooner canceled, changed or extended by order of the commission.
