ORDER

The verified application of Sacramento Northern Railway filed on June 3, 1963 discloses that no passenger or freight business has been transacted at applicant's station of Yolano in Solano County and at Riego in Placer County during the past two years and that continued maintenance thereof is not necessary.

Notice of the application has been given to various parties thought to be interested and no protests have been received. A public hearing does not appear to be necessary.

It is found that public convenience and necessity no longer require the maintenance of such service. Sacramento Northern Railway is hereby authorized to abandon its non-agency station of Yolano, County of Solano and Riego, County of Placer; to remove the spur and side tracks located at each of said stations; to eliminate said names from its station records; and to cancel all tariffs and time schedules applying at said stations on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and the public. Such tariff changes shall quote this decision number as the requisite authority. This order shall not be construed as authorization to increase rates or charges.

Within thirty days after abandonment and removal of the facilities as authorized herein, applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
