SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Capitol Tank Line, Inc., a corporation, has authority to operate as a highway common carrier and as a petroleum irregular route carrier for the transportation of petroleum and petroleum products in bulk and in tank trucks between all points and places in California. On May 31, 1963, it filed its amended articles of incorporation with this Commission changing its corporate name to Capitol Truck Line, Inc. Its operating certificate should be amended to show the new corporate name. It should also be ordered to amend its tariffs pursuant to General Order No. 80-A. A public hearing is not necessary.

Good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Decision No. ~~4444~~1 dated June 27, 1950, in Application No. 31507, and Decision No. 56787 dated June 4, 1958, in Application No. 39939, are amended by substituting "Capitol Truck Line, Inc." in place and stead of "Capitol Tank Line, Inc."

2. Within one hundred twenty days after the effective date hereof, and on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and the public, Capitol Truck Line, Inc. shall amend its tariffs on file with this Commission as required by Rule 6.4 of General Order No. 80-A.

This order shall become effective twenty days after the date hereof.
