SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Coronado Warehouse & Supply, Inc., a corporation, is authorized to operate as a public utility warehouseman in Coronado. Its amended articles of incorporation have been filed with this Commission changing its corporate name to COR-O-VAN Corporation. Accordingly, its operative rights will be amended to show the new corporate name. It will also be required to amend its tariffs pursuant to General Order No. 61-A. A public hearing is not necessary.

Good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The order dated August 23, 1960, in Case No. 6882, is hereby amended by substituting "COR-O-VAN Corporation" in place and stead of "Coronado Warehouse & Supply, Inc."

2. On the effective date hereof, the operative right as a public utility warehouseman set forth in the order dated August 23, 1960, in Case No. 6882, is hereby revoked, and in place and stead thereof, a prescriptive operative right as a public utility warehouseman is stated for COR-O-VAN Corporation as more particularly set forth in Appendix A attached hereto and made a part hereof.

3. Within one hundred twenty days after the effective date hereof, and on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and the public, COR-O-VAN Corporation shall amend its tariffs on file with this Commission as required by Rule 6.2 of General Order No. 61-A.

This order shall become effective twenty days after the date hereof.

COR-O-VAN Corporation, a corporation, possesses a prescriptive operative right as a public utility warehouseman for the operation of storage or warehouse floor space as follows:
