At the time of filing the application, applicants held radial highway common carrier and city carrier permits. On May 10, 1963, the permits of applicants were suspended for failure to have evidence of adequate liability insurance on file with the Commission as required by General Order No. 100-B. The permits were revoked on July 9, 1963. In the circumstances, the application will be dismissed.
