ORDER DISCONTINUING PORTION OF INVESTIGATION

The Commission, on July 25, 1961, instituted an investigation into the operations, services, rates and charges of all carriers of passengers or property in California. Due to the magnitude of such investigation it was divided into three parts. These were Sub 1 dealing with transportation by air, Sub 2 pertaining to the land transportation of property by any class of carrier other than air transportation companies and vessel operators, and Sub 3 relating to transportation by railroads, vessels, passenger stages and other means not included in the first two subdivisions. After discussion with those concerned and further review of the problems involved, it is concluded that there is no present need for an investigation of the segments of the transportation industry encompassed in Sub 1 and Sub 3. Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that the investigations contemplated by Case No. 7158, Sub 1 and Sub 3 only, are discontinued.
