FINAL ORDER

On January 10, 1961, the Commission issued an Interim Opinion and Interim Order (Decision No. 61327) in the above-entitled matter authorizing The Campbell Water Company to issue not to exceed \$170,500 par value of 5-1/2% preferred stock on or before December 31, 1962, but holding in abeyance a request by the company to issue \$215,900 par value of 3% preferred stock.

Counsel for applicant now has made written request to withdraw the application to issue the 3% stock. Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the request of The Campbell Water Company in Application No. 42838 for authorization to issue \$215,900 of 3% preferred stock is dismissed and the proceedings in Application No. 42838 are terminated.

This order shall become effective twenty days after the date hereof.
